New Submittal Eligibility

- All Projects must be eligible for federal or state-based funding programs.
- All Projects must be on, referenced in, (or amended to) a 6-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), Capital Facilities/Comprehensive Plan or Official Transportation Priority List.
- Non-Road Projects must be Transportation-based or Transportation-Related [Multi-modal]
- Road Projects must be federally classified (*no local access roads**) with a “Regional Impact” or “Focus”.
 - State Highway or Freeway
 - Urban (Major Arterial, Minor Arterial, Collector Arterial)
 - Rural (Major Collector, Minor Collector)
 - (*) – Local access roads [Only] if accessing regional employer or industrial park (with committee approval)
- Jurisdictions / organizations may have up to three (3) projects listed [unless multi-jurisdictional]
- Jurisdictions / organizations are not required to submit projects
- **WHO’S ELIGIBLE** – Local Jurisdictions
 - WSDOT
 - Yakama Nation
 - Port District(s)
 - Yakima (& Neighboring) Counties
 - Municipalities
 - Transit System(s)
- **WHO’S ELIGIBLE** – Agencies / Non-Profit organizations eligible to obtain State/Federal Grant Funds. All other entities must seek an aforementioned organization to act as a “sponsor”
- Updates to list will be made at the meeting(s) following the annual Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Period – [Approximately -- July 1st].
- **NOTE:** There should be very little turnover (except for completed projects). “Identified Need” projects should remain as such for several years if not otherwise fully-funded or completed.
