NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the voter registration deadlines for the November 3, 2009 General Election are as follows:

Individuals not already registered to vote must submit a registration application no later than October 5, 2009. This date also applies to voters transferring their registration.

Further, a late registration procedure is provided by RCW 29A.08.140. This statute authorizes an elector to register to vote beginning after the deadline for registration as described above and ending on the eighth day before the election. Accessible voting units will also be available for use on election day, November 3, 2009, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the following locations: Yakima County Auditor's Office, 128 N 2nd St, Yakima; Toppenish High School, 141 Ward Rd, Toppenish; and Sunnyside Work Source, 1925 Morgan Rd, Sunnyside.


All signatures are subject to verification by the Yakima County Canvassing Board or its duly authorized representatives.
