NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Primary will be held on Tuesday, August 17, 2010, in Yakima County, Washington, in all city, town, and rural precincts. Such Primary will be conducted entirely by mail ballot.

Voter registration deadlines: Standard deadline: Applications or updates must be postmarked or submitted no later than Monday, July 19, 2010. Registrations and updates may be submitted online at www.sos.wa.gov. Late deadline: For new voters in Washington State, in person registration at the County Auditor's Office closes Monday, August 9, 2010.

Voting by mail: Ballots are mailed to all eligible voters approximately 20 days prior to the date of the election. Replacement ballots: If a qualified voter does not receive a ballot or it is lost, spoiled or damaged, replacement ballots are available by contacting the Yakima County Auditor's Office at 509-574-1340. Returning voted ballots: Ballots will be counted only if signed by the qualified voter and either postmarked no later than August 17, 2010, or received by the Yakima County Auditor, 128 N 2nd St., #117, no later than 8:00 p.m. on that date. First class postage is required for returning a voted ballot by mail. Ballots may also be returned to any Designated Accessibility Site.

Designated Accessibility Sites: An ADA compliant and language assistance voting device is available for use at the Yakima County Auditor's Office, 128 N. 2nd St, #117, Yakima, during regular business hours 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday beginning July 28 through August 16, 2010. Accessible voting units are also available for use on election day, August 17, 2010, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the following locations: Yakima County Auditor's Office, 128 N 2nd St, Yakima; Toppenish High School, 141 Ward Rd, Toppenish; and Sunnyside Work Source, 1925 Morgan Rd, Sunnyside.

These registration deadlines and voting procedures pertain to the Primary being held on August 17, 2010.

On July 28, 2010, the Yakima County Auditor mailed each qualified voter within the county a mail ballot, voting instructions, and a pre-addressed envelope. Ballots will be counted only if the voter oath is signed by the qualified voter and either postmarked no later than August 17, 2010, or received by the Yakima County Auditor, Election Division, Yakima County Courthouse, 128 N 2nd St., #117, no later than 8:00 p.m. on that date. First class postage is required for returning a voted ballot by mail.

All signatures are subject to verification by the Yakima County Canvassing Board or its duly authorized representatives.

If a mail ballot is destroyed, spoiled, lost or not received by the voter, replacement ballots may be obtained from the Yakima County Auditor, Election Division, Yakima County Courthouse, Room 117, on or prior to August 17, 2010. On that day such office will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

On Election Day only (August 17, 2010) Designated Accessibility Sites are open for those voters who need assistance because of physical disabilities or language difficulties. Voters may return mail ballots at one of these Sites as well. The locations listed below are open between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
