In the Matter of Temporarily Closing a Portion of Tieton Reservoir Road for the South Fork Tieton River Fish Passage Project; FC3764

Background Information:

Yakima County will be restoring the alignment of the South Fork Tieton River channel and fish passage in and out of Rimrock Reservoir and constructing a new bridge. In order to safely work on this project, it is necessary to close a section of the roadway until the bridge work is complete. This work is scheduled to take place between November 17, 2025 and shall remain in place until August 7, 2026, or until the work is complete.

WHEREAS, the Yakima County Engineer has certified that it is necessary to close a portion of Tieton Reservoir Road, between NF Road 1000 and NF Road 1203 for the reconstruction of the South Fork Tieton River Fish Passage and construction of a new bridge. The road closure is effective November 17, 2025 and shall remain in place until August 7, 2026, or until the work is completed; **now, therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington that the closure of a portion of Tieton Reservoir Road is authorized and approved, and the roadway shall remain closed to through traffic until the necessary work has been completed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Contractor is to provide, install, and maintain sufficient traffic control devices, including barricades, at all times. All traffic control devices shall comply with the latest published Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, with modifications by the Washington State Department of Transportation, as adopted by the Secretary of Transportation. Notices of closures shall be posted at each point of closure. The adopted traffic control plan showing the traffic control devices, locations, and sizes the Contractor shall provide is included in the contract documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board did post and publish said closure as required by law.

Temporary Closure of a portion of Tieton Reservoir Road

NOTICE is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington, did pass a resolution authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of Tieton Reservoir Road, from NF Road 1000 and NF Road 1203. This closure is for the reconstruction of the South Fork Tieton River Fish Passage and construction of a new bridge.

Tieton Reservoir Road will be closed to through traffic from the east intersection of US 12 to the west intersection of US 12. Local access will be provided to property owners within the closure area, and public access to Yakima County Fire District and School District facilities. The temporary road closure will begin November 17, 2025 and shall remain in place until August 7, 2026, or until the work is complete and the roadway is restored for travel.
