Describe Fiscal Impact:

Yakima County has budgeted \$10,000 in the 2021 Budget for these purposes.

Background Information:

Commissioners passed resolution 124-2016 to fund reduced tipping fees at the Yakima County landfill for community cleanup days. The current resolution amends the 2016 resolution by allowing funding to cover tipping fees for the Yakima Greenway related to the cleanup of the homeless encampments along the Greenway.


Summary & Recommendation:

WHEREAS, Community service organizations, including churches, will often have community cleanup days to remove trash and debris from around the County to make Yakima County a cleaner, safer community, and to enhance the quality of life in the valley; and,

WHEREAS, the Yakima Greenway works with community partners such as Camp Hope to clean up homeless camps along the Greenway, and requests support to cover the costs of tipping fees at the County landfill; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners (BOCC) believe it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Yakima County to allocate General Fund resources in the annual budget to support the Yakima Greenway and these community service organizations cleanup days by supporting reduced tipping fees for disposal of collected trash and debris in the County landfill; now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Yakima Greenway and community service organizations may request support from the BOCC for the cost of tipping fees at the County landfill. Requests may be approved in writing by the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners up to the amount adopted for community cleanup in the annual budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Yakima County Commissioners agree to allocate General Fund resources up to \$10,000 at the Board's discretion during the annual budget adoption to support community service organizations cleanup days in Yakima County.
