Background Information:


All 4th of July community activities were prohibited in 2020 due to the COVID pandemic. In 2021, these activities will be allowed with the June 30, 2021 restriction reductions proposed by the State. County Commissioners believe the July 4th celebrations are a community event with fireworks to be enjoyed by all residents.

Summary & Recommendation:

Recommend approving the funding and support for fireworks displays at State Fair Park up to \$15,000 and in the City of Sunnyside for up to \$5,000.

**WHEREAS**, on July 4, 2021, Yakima County residents will be celebrating the national holiday of our great Country's independence with community celebrations and fireworks displays; and,

**WHEREAS**, July 4, 2021, will have extra special meaning with the easing of restrictions due to COVID, allowing County citizens to celebrate this 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday together, which was not allowed in 2020 due to COVID, with a public firework display at the State Fair Park and in Sunnyside; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners supports the return of these community events in 2021 and agrees to support a portion of the costs of these firework celebrations, which all citizens of the County benefit; now, therefore,

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** the Board of Yakima County Commissioners agree to fund up to \$15,000 towards the fireworks display at State Fair Park, payable to the Central Washington Fair Association.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the Board of Yakima County Commissioners agree to fund up to \$5,000 towards the community fireworks display in Sunnyside, payable to the Sunnyside Lions Club.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Auditor and Treasurer and other County Departments affected are hereby directed to implement the terms of this resolution as of the date approved.
