WHEREAS, RCW 36.32 provides authority for the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington to alter the stop and yield signs upon County roads within Yakima County, Washington; **and**,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 5-2021 established the maximum speed for all vehicles traveling upon certain County roads, or parts of such roads; **and**,

WHEREAS, a petition for the lowering of the speed limit on all of American Fruit Road from 35 mph to 15 mph was received; **and**,

WHEREAS, the County Engineer recommends the addition and/or deletion of a 25 mph, when flagged or when flashing school zone at the following Yakima County roads:

**CURTIS STREET, FROM 330 FT NORTHWEST OF E ELM AVE, TO 340
FT SOUTHWEST OF E ELM AVE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners feels it is in the best interest of the citizens of Yakima County to hold a public hearing to consider changing Ordinance No. 5-2021, and adopting Ordinance No. 6-2021; **now, therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington that on **Tuesday, August 10th, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as possible in the Yakima County Courthouse Basement, Room 33B, Conference Room 2, 128 North 2nd Street, Yakima, Washington, be and hereby is, set as the time and place to hold a public hearing to consider changing Ordinance No. 5-2021 at which time and place all persons may be heard for or against the proposed stop and yield sign alterations and other stop and yield sign matters as may come before the Board for consideration, and that notice of such hearing be given by one publication in the Yakima Herald-Republic at least ten days prior to the hearing date.
