WHEREAS, Ms. Padilla claims Yakima County should pay her \$300 to replace her surveillance DVD that was taken by the Yakima County Sheriff's Office (YSO) as part of an investigation into a shooting on February 14, 2021 (the "Incident"); **and**,

WHEREAS, the Corporate Counsel Division of the Yakima County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has investigated Ms. Padilla's claim and recommends settlement of all claims relating to the Incident, without admission of liability by any party, by payment of the settlement amount of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) to Anna Padilla, in exchange for a complete settlement and release of all claims relating to the Incident; **now, therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that Yakima County pay Ms. Padilla Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) to settle all claims relating to the Incident, without admission of liability by any party.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board is authorized and directed to submit a copy of this resolution to Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Don Anderson to arrange for payment from Yakima County Fund 520 of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) to Anna Padilla as full consideration for a complete settlement and release of all claims relating to the Incident, in such terms and form as is satisfactory to the Yakima County Prosecuting Attorney. The Chief Civil Deputy is further authorized to take whatever actions are reasonable and prudent to conclude the settlement provided by this resolution.
