WHEREAS, Yakima County allocates a portion of its road funds every year to improve the local access roads as determined by the County Engineer; **and**,

WHEREAS, based on information from the County Engineer, it is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington to improve Collins Road from Grabenstein Road to the end of County right of way by contract; **and**,

WHEREAS, funding for the Collins Road Improvement project are local funds and included in the officially adopted Yakima County Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program, 2022 – 2027, under Item No. 26; **now, therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that the County Engineer is directed to prepare plans, specifications and an estimate of cost and advertise for construction bids for the aforesaid Collins Road Improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds for construction of this roadway in the amount of \$1,100,000 are hereby authorized and appropriated from County Road funds, and the project is designated Yakima County Project C 3575.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids shall be received by Yakima County Road Department, 4th Floor, Yakima County Courthouse, Yakima, Washington until **2:00 p.m., Thursday, February 24, 2022** at which time the bids shall be opened and publicly read for the letting of one contract involving the following work:

Yakima County Project Number RC 3575, for improving approximately 1.15 miles of Collins Road, from Grabenstein Road to End of County Road, with the following major items of work and other associated items of work as detailed in the contract plans and specifications:
