WHEREAS, the Yakima County Engineer has certified that it is necessary to close a portion of Morrier Lane, for the reconstruction and widening of Morrier Lane. The road closure is effective February 19, 2022 and shall remain in place until February 28, 2022 or until the work is completed; **now, therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington that the closure of a portion of Morrier Lane is authorized and approved, and the roadway shall remain closed to through traffic until the necessary work has been completed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Contractor is to provide, install, and maintain sufficient traffic control devices, including barricades, at all times. All traffic control devices shall comply with the latest published Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, with modifications by the Washington State Department of Transportation, as adopted by the Secretary of Transportation. Notices of closures shall be posted at each point of closure. The adopted traffic control plan showing the traffic control devices, locations, and sizes the Contractor shall provide is included in the contract documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board did post and publish said closure as required by law.

Temporary Closure of a portion of Morrier Lane

NOTICE is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington, did pass a resolution authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of Morrier Lane, from Mieras Road to Norman Road, for the reconstruction and widening of Morrier Lane.

Morrier Lane will be closed to through traffic, between Mieras Road and Norman Road. Local access will be provided to property owners within the closure area, and public access to Yakima County Fire District and School District facilities. The temporary road closure will begin February 19, 2022 and shall remain in place until February 28, 2022 or until the work is complete and the roadway is restored for travel.
