Yakima County Roads agreement will provide \$3,664.97 of revenue for dispatch.



**ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT
Communications/2022**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the Yakima County Sheriff (hereinafter referred to as the Sheriff) and Yakima County Road Department (hereinafter referred to as Public Services Department), effective on the 1st day of January 2022.

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual promise contained herein, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

1. PURPOSE.

It is the purpose and intent of this agreement that the Sheriff, by and through his communications center, shall provide telephone and radio communication service for the Public Services Department during hours in which the County Road Department has no radio personnel on duty.

2. DUTIES OF THE SHERIFF.

It shall be the duty of the Sheriff to provide and make available personnel to respond to radio communications for the County Road Department twenty-four hours a day on holidays and twenty-four hour coverage from 4:00 PM Friday until 7:30 AM the following weekday during the normal work week. (Monday through Friday.)

3. DUTIES OF THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT.

It shall be the duty of the County Road Department to provide an open telephone line and equipment capable of switching incoming calls to the Sheriff during hours when the County Road Department has no dispatchers on duty.

4. PAYMENT

For the services provided by the Sheriff, the County Road Department shall pay the Yakima County Sheriff's Office a quarterly fee of nine hundred sixteen dollars and twenty-four (\$916.24) for an annual cost of three thousand six hundred sixty-four dollars and ninety-seven cents, (\$3,664.97). The Sheriff shall bill the County Road Department on a quarterly basis with statements being sent to the County Road Department by the 10th of the month succeeding each quarter. Such statements will be payable by the end of the month in which they are received.

5. TERM

The term of this agreement is January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.


6. MODIFICATION.

This contract may be modified only by written agreement of the parties.

7. TERMINATION.

This contract may be terminated only upon thirty days written notice by either party to the other, and then only because of a breach of the agreement or because the recited purpose of the contract becomes inapplicable.
