Describe Fiscal Impact:

The fiscal impact total will be \$20,000, with \$15,000 for the State Fair Park fireworks, and \$5,000 for a southern portion of Yakima County site yet to be determined.

Background Information:

All 4th of July community activities were prohibited in 2020 due to the COVID pandemic. In 2021, Yakima County celebrated the July 4th holiday with record crowds at State Fair Park. Yakima County Commissioners believe the July 4th celebrations are a community building event with fireworks to be enjoyed by all residents.


Summary & Recommendation:

Recommend approving the funding and support for fireworks displays at State Fair Park up to \$15,000 and in the southern portion of Yakima County for up to \$5,000.
