WHEREAS, the Yakima County Engineer has certified that it is necessary to close a portion of W White Swan Road, from the intersection with Hawk Road to the intersection with Wesley Road, for the Simcoe Creek Diversion and the bridge installation. The road closure will be for approximately two weeks beginning September 22, 2022 through October 7, 2022, and shall remain in place until the work is complete and the roadway is restored for travel; **now, therefore,**

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington that the closure of a portion of W White Swan Road is authorized and approved, and the roadway shall remain closed until the necessary construction has been completed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Yakima Nation Fisheries is to provide, install, and maintain sufficient traffic control devices, including barricades at all times. All traffic control devices shall comply with the latest published Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, with modifications by the Washington State Department of Transportation, as adopted by the Secretary of Transportation. Notices of closures shall be posted at each point of closure.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board shall post and publish a notice of said closure in the advertisement section of the local newspaper at least 3 days prior to the closure.

Temporary Closure of a portion of W White Swan Road

Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington, did pass a resolution authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of W White Swan Road, from the intersection with Hawk Road to near the intersection with Wesley Road. This road closure is for the Simcoe Creek diversion and the installation of the bridge.

W White Swan Road will be closed to through traffic from Hawk Road to Wesley Road. Local access will be provided to property owners within the closure area, and public access to Yakima County Fire District and School District facilities. The temporary road closure will be for approximately two weeks beginning September 22, 2022 through October 7, 2022, and shall remain in place until the work is complete and the roadway is restored for travel.
