WHEREAS, Yakima County has received in excess of \$48 million from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic and received over 150 applications from our community for grant requests to receive these funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Yakima County Sheriff has requested the purchase of an armored vehicle to support the increased need for crisis situations such as active shooter, hostage situation, riot or possible explosive threat, and will support other jurisdictions within the County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners believes it to be in the best interest of the County to allocate up to \$350,000 in ARPA funds to the Sheriff's Office for the purchase of an armored vehicle; now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners to allocate up to \$350,000 in ARPA funds for the purchase of an armored vehicle for the Yakima County Sheriff's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Auditor's Office and the County Treasurer's Office shall implement this resolution immediately.
