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WHEREAS, Yakima County has received in excess of \$48 million from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic and received over 150 applications from our community for grant requests to receive these funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Yakima County Sheriff has requested the creation and funding of a Pro Active Law Enforcement Unit of (4) deputies and (1) sergeant to detect, deter and eliminate criminal activity and negative quality of life issues throughout Yakima County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners believes it to be in the best interest of the County to allocate up to \$4,002,567 in ARPA funds to the Sheriff's Office for the creation of a Pro Active Law Enforcement Unit for the Sheriff's Office; now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners to allocate up to \$4,002,567 in ARPA funds for the creation and funding of a Pro Active Law Enforcement Unit for the Yakima County Sheriff's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Auditor's Office and the County Treasurer's Office shall implement this resolution immediately.
