**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 13-2021 established the maximum speed of all vehicles traveling upon certain County roads, or parts of such roads; **and**,

**WHEREAS**, the following petition was received requesting speed limit changes.

**Skyview Court**, reduce the speed limit from 25 mph to 15 mph

**WHEREAS**, the County Engineer recommends changing the speed limit on the following portions of Yakima County roads:

**Skyview Court**, from mile point 0.00 to 0.11 (End of Road) from 25 mph for east and westbound traffic to 20 mph.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners feels it is in the best interest of the citizens of Yakima County to hold a public hearing to consider changing Ordinance No. 13-2021; **now therefore**,

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that a public hearing be held on **Tuesday December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon as possible thereafter, on the proposals listed on the attached legal notice for the purpose of considering the proposed Ordinance.
