Background Information:


To repair the Cheyne Transfer Station floor and to install the material handling crane pad at the Terrace Heights Transfer Station. Original construction of the floor did not imbed the steel loading frame in the concrete leading to serious damage that needs repaired. The material crane at Terrace Heights will allow for better packing of trailers and phase in the needs/costs for transferring garbage to Cheyne Landfill when the Terrace Heights landfill is full.

Summary & Recommendation:

Authorize the advertisement for bids to repair the Cheyne Transfer Station floor and construction of the Terrace Heights Transfer Station crane pad and exits.
