Describe Fiscal Impact:
This amendment reduces the grant amount of \$250,00 by \$65,000 for an amended total of \$185,000 of stabilization funds for refugees.

Background Information:
Fewer than anticipated refugees have arrived in the Yakima area. Washington State Commerce plans deploy these funds to other counties who have more Ukraine conflict arrivals than anticipated. This amendment reduces the grant amount of \$250,00 by \$65,000 for an amended total of \$185,000 of stabilization funds for refugees.

Summary & Recommendation:
Fewer than anticipated refugees have arrived in the Yakima area and the contract is being reduced by \$65,000 from \$250,00 to \$185,000.
Recommended to approve the contract amendment.
