
Background Information:

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 39.04.280 provides for the exemption from the competitive bidding requirements; **and**,

WHEREAS, competitive bidding requirements may be waived by the governing body of the municipality for purchase that are clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supplier purchases involving Sole Source; **and**,

WHEREAS, Yakima County Department of Corrections requires a replacement video server as part of its existing system that was purchased through CML Security. This is an important purchase for the continuity of the operation of cameras monitoring the Yakima County Jail; **and**,

WHEREAS, a notice of intent to make a sole source purchase from CML Security was passed by resolution 071-2023; **now, therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that the bidding requirement be, and hereby is, waived pursuant to R.C.W. 39.04.280 and that CML Security is authorized as a sole source vendor for this purchase.
