



**BOARD OF YAKIMA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RESOLUTION**

**IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING
SETTLEMENT OF CLAIM No. 13-2023
FILED BY GARRETT AND TINA WARDELL**

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WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Wardell claim Yakima County should pay them \$22,865.05 for the cost to repair damage to their garage, laundry room, storage room and replace some personal items that were damaged on March 25, 2023; **and**,

WHEREAS, the Corporate Counsel Division of the Yakima County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has investigated Mr. and Mrs. Wardell's claim and recommends settlement of all claims relating to the Incident, without admission of liability by any party, by payment of Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents (\$18,650.72) to Garrett and Tina Wardell in exchange for a complete settlement and release of all claims relating to the Incident; **and**,

WHEREAS, the Washington Counties Risk Pool (WCRP), subject to reimbursement by Yakima County, will prepare and deliver payment of Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents (\$18,650.72) to Garrett and Tina Wardell as settlement of this claim; **now therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that Yakima County pay Garrett and Tina Wardell Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents (\$18,650.72) to settle all claims relating to the Incident, without admission of liability by any party; **now, therefore**,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, Corporate Counsel is authorized and directed to provide a copy of this resolution to Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Don Anderson so that he may arrange for payment from Yakima County Fund 520 of a total of Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents (\$18,650.72) to reimburse the Washington Counties Risk Pool for the settlement payment. The Chief Civil Deputy is further authorized to take whatever actions are reasonable and prudent to conclude the settlement provided by this resolution.
