WHEREAS, RCW 36.81.121 sets forth that each county in the State of Washington shall prepare and adopt a comprehensive road program for the ensuing six years; **and**,

WHEREAS, in compliance with said law, the Board of County Commissioners did adopt by Resolution No. 202-2022, dated November 11, 2022, the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2023 to 2028; **and**,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 184-2023, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on Tuesday, August 8, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. to receive comments on amending the six-year transportation improvement program for 2023 to 2028 for the inclusion of one (1) additional project; **and**

WHEREAS, there were no comments in opposition to the amendment of the six-year transportation improvement program to include the addition of reconstructing the rail crossing of the Toppenish-Simcoe Railroad on SR 97; **now, therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2023 to 2028 is amended to include one (1) project titled "Reconstruct Railroad Crossing of Toppenish-Simcoe Railroad."
