WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington did pass Resolution No. 461-2006, adopting the Naches River Comprehensive Flood Hazard Management Plan (CFHMP); **and**,

WHEREAS, the Naches River CFHMP identified certain high priority projects to reduce flood hazards, including addressing flood risks near Rambler's Park; **and**,

WHEREAS, Yakima County Public Services – Water Resources Division applied for and was successful in securing a grant with the purpose of reversing the 100-year floodplain degradation to reduce flood risks, which was designated as Yakima County project FC3664; **and**,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County entered into agreement BOCC221-2018 to implement the project, which is included in the officially adopted Yakima County 2023-2028 Capital Improvement Plan – Flood Control; **and**,

WHEREAS, under Resolution 65-2019, the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County directed the Public Services Director to acquire the necessary fee simple interest, conservation easements or flood easements for the aforesaid FC3664 project to reduce flood risks on the Naches River in the immediate vicinity of Rambler's Park, which was acquired; **and**,

WHEREAS, the Water Resources Division has prepared plans, specifications, and an estimate of costs for the Project; **now, therefore**,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that the Chairman of the Board is authorized to approve the plans and specifications for constructing the aforesaid improvements as prepared by the Water Resources Division for contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board is directed to post and publish legal notice as required by law, and that specifications for this bid shall be available from the temporary office of the County Engineer, 1216 South 18th Street, Yakima, Washington 98901.

Yakima County Project Number FC 3664: Ramblers Reach Phase VI Floodplain Restoration Project. The work to be performed under this Contract involves the removal and reconstruction of an existing earthen embankment and the construction of several side channels in the floodplain adjacent to the Naches River, with the following major items of work and other associated items of work as detailed in the contract plans and specifications:
