**WHEREAS**, to apply for Community Development Block Grant funds (CDBG), a jurisdiction must show it has involved its citizens in the CDBG application process and complied with the specific federal citizen participation requirements; **and**,

**WHEREAS**, the 2019 Public Service Grant contracts are approaching their end, a public hearing that reviews the county's and community action agency's performance and use of CDBG funds is required as part of this contract's close-out process; **and**,

**WHEREAS**, it is advisable to combine the public hearing requirements for the 2020 application and the 2019 closeout process into one public hearing; **now, therefore**,

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that Tuesday, March 31, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, in Yakima City Council Chambers, 129 North 2nd Street, Yakima, Washington, is the time and place set for public hearing to consider comments and review the educational and employment needs of low- and moderate-income residents, inform citizens of the availability of funds and eligible uses of the state Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this date is set to receive comments on the county's and Community Action Agency's performance and use of their 2019 CDBG Public Service Grant award.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Clerk of the Board shall post and publish said hearing as required by state statute.
