That the total number of registered voters in all precincts was 71,760, and that the total number of votes cast in such precincts was 43,430.

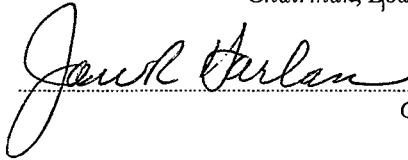
