Your voter registration has been challenged by Mario Moreno Martinez, based on the belief that you do not live at the address where you are registered to vote. The challenge process is established in the law RCW 29A.08.810 through RCW 29A.08.850. Voter registration records show your residential address as:

If this is incorrect, you may update your information by contacting our office at 509-574-1340.

A hearing regarding this challenge has been scheduled for Tuesday, December 12, 2017 at 10 a.m. at the Yakima County Courthouse / Auditor's Office, 128 N 2<sup>nd</sup> St Room 117, Yakima WA 98901. A voter registration challenge hearing is an administrative hearing, not a court proceeding, and will be open to the public. The County Auditor will preside over the hearing.

You may provide evidence that you live at the address where you are registered, update your residential address at **[www.myvote.wa.gov](http://www.myvote.wa.gov)**, or prove that you meet one of the exceptions allowed in law. You do not lose your residency if you are:

- absent while in government service;
- attending school;
- confined in a public prison; or
- live at a non-traditional residential address. State law allows you to list the address of a shelter, park, motor home, marina, or other identifiable location that you consider to be your residence.

You may respond by appearing at the hearing in person, or by submitting written testimony. A sample declaration is enclosed. If you decide to respond in writing, it must be received by our office prior to the hearing. If you do not participate in the hearing, a decision will be made based on available information and you will be contacted regarding the outcome of the hearing.
