WHO: Yakima Health District

WHAT: Free HIV Screening Event

WHY: HIV disproportionately affects the Latino community. In 2015, Hispanics/Latinos accounted for 24% of new diagnoses of HIV infection. An estimated 1 in 4 of individuals living with HIV do not know they have the virus. Individuals should get tested frequently to know their status. Resources will be available for those who identify as high-risk or test positive for HIV at this event.
