Shall property taxes in excess of statutory and constitutional limitations be levied and collected over a two year period of time in order to provide for the general operating expenses of Union Gap School District No. 2, said levies to be \$245,000.00 in excess taxes (approximately \$2.47 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation) for collection in 1987, and \$240,000.00 in excess taxes (estimated to be approximately \$2.42 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation) for collection in 1988?
