INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS

Those desiring to vote in favor of the proposition should place a cross in the square to the right of the words, "Tax Levy—Yes" which appear at the end of the proposition; those opposed should place a cross in the square to the right of the words, "Tax Levy—No" which appear at the end of the proposition.

PROPOSITION

GENERAL OPERATING EXPENSES LEVY

Shall a tax levy of \$115,000.00, the estimated millage required to produce such amount being 5 mills (based upon an assessment ratio of 50% of actual value), in excess of the maximum tax levy provided by law for school districts without a vote of the electors, be made in 1972 for collection in 1973 upon all taxable property of Naches Valley School District Jt. 3, Yakima County, Washington, for the General Fund of the District, the proceeds of said levy to be used immediately through incurring an indebtedness against the district by the issuance of warrants against the General Fund of the District to provide funds necessary to meet operating expenses of the District, all as more specifically provided in a resolution, adopted by the Board of Directors of the School District on January 10, 1972?
