**PROPOSITION**  
**GENERAL OPERATING EXPENSES LEVY**

Shall a tax levy of \$2,016,520.00, the estimated millage required to produce such amount being 10.3 mills, (based upon an assessment ratio of 50% of actual value), in excess of the maximum tax levy provided by law for school districts without a vote of the electors, be made in 1972 for collection in 1973 upon all taxable property of Yakima School District No. 7, Yakima County, Washington, for the General Fund of the district, the proceeds of said levy to be used immediately through incurring an indebtedness against the District to provide funds necessary to meet general operating expenses of the District, all as more specifically provided in a Resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of the School District on December 10, 1971?
