

Proposition No. 2
SCHOOL DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT BONDS,
\$350,000

Shall Wapato School District No. 207, Yakima County, Washington, issue its general obligation bonds in the principal amount of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may be issued and sold under the laws governing the limitation of indebtedness of school districts, such bonds to be payable, both principal and interest, out of annual tax levies to be made without limitation as to rate or amount, to bear interest at a rate not to exceed the maximum rate permitted by law at the time the bonds are sold, and to mature as provided by law and resolution of the Board of Directors within twenty years from date of issue, for the purpose of providing funds to pay part of the cost of acquiring, constructing and installing new lighting facilities and carpeting at the Junior High, Parker, Parker Heights, Primary, Intermediate and Senior High Schools and new windows and lockers at the Junior High and new lighting facilities, tennis courts, and an additional room for arts and crafts at the Senior High School, and if available funds are sufficient shall acquire, construct, equip and make other capital improvements to the facilities of the district, all as more specifically provided in a resolution of the Board of Directors adopted February 22, 1971?
