
PROPOSITION NO. 2
GENERAL FUND MAINTENANCE, OPERATING,
AND IMPROVEMENT LEVY

Shall a tax levy of \$196,314.00, the estimated millage required to produce such amount being 5.40 mills (based upon an assessment ratio of 50% of actual value), in excess of the maximum tax levy provided by law for school districts without a vote of the electors, be made in 1971 for collection in 1972 upon all taxable property of West Valley School District No. 208, Yakima County, Washington, for the General Fund of the District, the proceeds of said levy to be used commencing in the 1971-72 school year through incurring an indebtedness against the District by the issuance of warrants against the General Fund of the District to provide funds necessary to employ additional employees, paint and repair buildings, purchase books, supplies, and equipment, and improve the vocational education program, all as more specifically provided in a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of the West Valley School District on January 18, 1971?
