







1. Sign in and open Google Maps.
2. Click Menu  Your places  Maps.
3. To edit a map, choose a map and click Open in My Maps. You'll be taken to My Maps, where you can edit your map.

Note: If you're using Maps in Lite mode, you can't view your My Maps in Google Maps.
