WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that the terms of Dorothy Warren, Richard H. Hayland and Daniel F. Mayer will expire on December 31, 1981, as members of the Yakima County Mosquito Control District; and,

WHEREAS it is incumbent upon this Board, pursuant to R.C.W. 17.28.130 (2), to appoint the members of said Board; and,

WHEREAS, Dorothy Warren, Richard H. Hayland and Daniel F. Mayer have indicated a willingness to continue to serve and this Board reposing special trust and confidence in these people; now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Yakima County Commissioners that Dorothy Warren, Richard H. Hayland and Daniel F. Mayer be, and they hereby are, re-appointed to the Yakima County Mosquito Control District, effective January 1, 1982.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said re-appointments shall be for two year terms and such terms shall expire December 3, 1983.

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners has received petitions signed by registered voters of the Terrace Heights area asking for the formation of a Terrace Heights Mosquito Control District; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners, pursuant to RCW 17.38.070, has mailed notice to all property owners within the proposed Terrace Heights District whose lands were inadvertantly excluded from the original petition; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners has received a petition signed by registered voters of the East Selah area asking for the formation of such a district and inclusion into the proposed Terrace Heights District; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners has given proper notice to conduct a public hearing in the above matter; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners has heard testimony from citizens of the proposed districts and other concerned individuals that mosquitoes within the proposed district are a definite health hazard, being carriers of various diseases, including encephalitis, and further constitute a considerable nuisance to the citizens of the proposed district in that mosquitoes interfere with normal outdoor recreational pursuits of the citizens of the proposed district; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners has determined that the public necessity and welfare of the proposed district and of its inhabitants requires the formation of a mosquito control district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners has determined that the petitions comply with the provisions of RCW 17.28; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners has the power,  
under RCW 17.28.060 to make such changes in the proposed boundaries as are desirable;  
now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Yakima County Commissioners finds  
that the public necessity and welfare requires the formation of a mosquito control dis-  
trict and orders that the territory within the boundaries so fixed and determined as  
described herein on "Exhibit A" be organized as a mosquito control district, under  
the name MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT #1, subject to the approval  
of the voters of the district in a special election to be held in conjunction with the  
primary election on September 21, 1976.

3306 East Selah, 3106 Butterfield, 4606 Slavin, 4802 Terrace Hgts.,  
3206 Country Club, and the west portion of 4106 North Holland

Beginning at the intersection of the Yakima-Kittitas County Line and the Yakima River, bordering on the west, proceeding southerly on the Yakima River to the intersection of the Yakima River and the south line of the N.W. quarter of Sec. 28, Tn. 13, Range 19. Proceeding east to the S.E. corner of the N.W. quarter of Sec. 27, Tn. 13, Range 19, then south to the S.W. corner of the S.E. quarter of Sec. 27, Tn. 13, Range 19. Bordering on the south, proceeding easterly to the S.E. corner of Sec. 25, Tn. 13, Range 20, then northerly to the S.E. corner of Sec. 12, Tn. 13, Range 20, then easterly to the S.E. corner of Sec. 12, Tn. 13, Range 21. Bordering on the east, proceeding northerly to the Yakima-Kittitas County line. Bordering on the north, proceeding west to the point of beginning.
