

AUDITOR'S CERTIFICATE OF SPECIAL CITY ELECTION
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE
YAKIMA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

I, Chet Hatfield, Auditor, Yakima County, Washington, and ex-officio Supervisor of Elections, do hereby certify that a special election was held in the City of Sunnyside, Yakima County, Washington, on the 5th day of April, 1977, for the purpose of deciding upon the propositions hereinafter set forth, and that the results of said election were as indicated following the propositions:

PROPOSITION NO. 1 - BOND ISSUE SALE FOR SENIOR CITIZENS' CENTER:

Shall the City of Sunnyside, Washington, incur a general indebtedness of not to exceed \$100,000.00, and issue general obligation bonds therefor, such bonds to mature in dates of from two to ten years after issuance, to be payable from annual property tax levies to be made without limitation as to rate or amount, the net proceeds of such bonds to be used for the purpose of constructing a multi-purpose senior citizens' center, all as provided in Ordinance No. 1137.

The ballots cast at the aforesaid election relative to Proposition No. 1 were as follows:

PROPOSITION NO. 2 - BOND ISSUE SALE FOR SOUTH PARK:

Shall the City of Sunnyside, Washington, incur a general indebtedness of not to exceed \$130,000.00, and issue general obligation bonds therefor, such bonds to mature in dates of from two to ten years after issuance, to be payable from annual property tax levies to be made without limitation as to rate or amount, the net proceeds of such bonds to be used for the purpose of developing a South Sunnyside Park by landscaping, providing parking and recreational areas, installing utilities and providing recreational equipment, the issuance of such bonds to be subject, however, to receipt of a commitment of funds from the Washington State Interagency Committee on or before October 31, 1978 of at least \$387,000.00, provided, however, if such commitment is not received by such date in such amount, such bonds shall be issued and the proceeds thereof utilized to make such park development

PROPOSITION NO. 2 - Continued-

to the extent the funds permit, all as provided in Ordinance No. 1138.


