

IN THE MATTER OF CANVASSING THE
RETURNS OF THE SPECIAL TOWN
ELECTION HELD MARCH 13, 1951,
RELATIVE TO PLACING A SPECIAL
LEVY OF 3 MILLS BY THE TOWN OF
ZILLAH, YAKIMA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

We, the undersigned members of the legally constituted Canvassing Board of Yakima County, Washington, do hereby certify that we have this day canvassed the returns of the special election held on March 13, 1951, in the Town of Zillah, Yakima County, Washington, for approval or rejection of the following:

PROPOSITION:

Shall the Town of Zillah levy three (3) mills on the dollar of assessed valuation of the real and personal property within the corporate limits of the Town of Zillah, over and above the fifteen (15) mills authorized by law to be levied by the Town Council, to provide funds for dust oiling streets and other public thoroughfares during 1951?

and find the following:

<u>214</u>	votes cast upon the Proposition
<u>171</u>	votes cast for the Proposition
<u>43</u>	votes cast against the Proposition
<u>303</u>	votes cast in precinct 113 at the last General Election on November 7, 1950

Therefore, we declare the following:

PROPOSITION APPROVED.
