HOW TO SUBMIT APPEALS

1. In order to file an appeal, you will need to include the following:
 - a. Information indicating that the elevations and/or delineations are scientifically and/or technically incorrect.
 - b. Scientific and technical data as well as mapping which demonstrate that alternative methods or applications result in more correct estimates of Base Flood Elevations.
2. To file your appeal, please submit a signed letter with the corresponding technical information to your respective jurisdiction (see addresses above). Comments and appeals are due by the end of the 90-day appeal period (Appeal Period Start: May 29, 2019; Appeal Period End: August 2019).

Local officials will review and submit the information formally to FEMA. If you are an owner or lessee of real property within the flood update area, you may also submit appeals directly to FEMA at rscx@starr-team.com, as desired.
