A Public petition was received requesting a speed limit change:

Postma Road, from Iler Road/Duffield Road/Moxee City Limits to St. Hilaire Road, from unposted to 35mph.

Based on review of the petition, The County Engineer will recommend the following changes:

Postma Road, from Moxee City Limits to Faucher Road, from unposted to 40 mph.

Postma Road, from Faucher Road to St. Hilaire Road, from unposted to 45 mph.

Yakima County citizens are invited to attend and participate in the public hearing and will be given the opportunity to make comments for or against the proposed speed limit alterations to Ordinance No. 3-2020.
