NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Yakima County, Washington, a public hearing has been called and will be held in the Yakima County Courthouse Basement, Room 33B, Conference Room 2, 128 North 2nd Street, Yakima, Washington on **Tuesday, January 4, 2022 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as possible so that all persons may be heard for or against amending Ordinance No. 1-2016 concerning the imposition and collection of an additional three-tenths percent (.03%) sales and use tax for criminal justice services.

The Board of Commissioners will consider permanently authorizing the continued imposition and collection of an additional three-tenths of one percent (.03%) Sales and Use Tax for criminal justice services, commencing in 2023, as authorized by state law and approved by the majority of the persons voting on Proposition 1 in the general election held on November 3, 2021.

Yakima County citizens are invited to attend and participate in the public hearing and will be given the opportunity to make comments for or against the proposed continued permanent imposition and collection of an additional sales and use tax from those persons who are taxable by the state pursuant to chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW upon the occurrence of any taxable event with Yakima County, to be incorporated within a proposed amendment to Ordinance No. 1-2016.

Copies of the full text of the proposed amendment to Ordinance No. 1-2016 will be available for public viewing in the office of the Board of Yakima County Commissioners, Room 232 County Courthouse, Yakima, Washington 98901.
