



## **Yakima County Homeless Housing and Assistance Program Grants Awarded for the Grant Cycle starting July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2024**

YAKIMA – The Homeless Housing and Assistance Program (HHAP) funds, which comprise both Local 2163 revenues and State Consolidated Homeless Grant (CHG) dollars, have been awarded for the upcoming grant cycle (starting July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2024).

Grants have been awarded in the following amounts:

### Shelter/Sanctioned Encampment

- Generating Hope: \$79,364
- Grace City Outreach: \$445,920
- Rod's House: \$104,766
- Yakima Neighborhood Health Services: \$69,675

### Domestic Violence Shelter

- Yakima YWCA: \$140,000

### Extreme Winter Weather Shelter

- Rod's House: \$56,750
- Yakima Neighborhood Health Services: \$51,625
- Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinic: \$51,625

### Youth and Young Adults Shelter

- Grace City Outreach: \$100,000
- Rod's House: \$120,000

### Capital Project

- Rod's House: \$250,000
- Yakima Neighborhood Health Services: \$160,275

### Coordinated Entry (Adults)

- Yakima Neighborhood Health Services: \$71,300
- Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinic: \$18,700

#### Coordinated Entry (Youth)

- Rod's House: \$15,000
- Yakima Neighborhood Health Services: \$0

#### Outreach

- Generating Hope: \$14,010
- Grace City Outreach: \$94,740
- Rod's House: \$30,000
- Yakima Neighborhood Health Services: \$70,000
- Yakima Union Gospel Mission: \$21,250

- Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinic: \$533,139
