



COVID-19 Vaccine Guide

Who is eligible for the primary series? (initial doses)

Anyone 6 months and older



The primary vaccination series varies by vaccine type and age group.

Pfizer Primary Series:

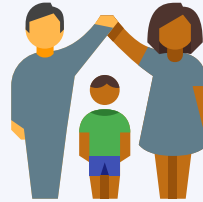
- **6 mos. - 4 years:** 2 doses, 3 weeks apart, followed by a 3rd dose 2 months later
- **5 years & older:** 2 doses, 3 weeks apart

Moderna Primary Series:

- **6 mos. & older:** 2 doses, 4 weeks apart

Who is eligible for a booster dose?

Anyone 5 and older who has completed their primary vaccination series.



- **If you received Pfizer and are 5 and older,** you may get a booster dose at least 5 months after the second dose.
- **If you received Moderna and are 18 and older,** you may get a booster dose at least 5 months after the second dose.
- **If you received Johnson & Johnson and are 18 and older,** you may get a booster dose at least 2 months after the first dose.

Who is eligible for a second booster dose?

The following groups are eligible for a second booster dose 4 months after their first booster dose:



Everyone 50 and older and certain immunocompromised individuals who are 12 and older.



People 18 and older who received a primary vaccine and booster dose of the **J&J vaccine** may receive a second booster dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine.

Note: Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines are preferred over Johnson & Johnson's COVID-19 vaccine in most situations.
