### Items Discussed:

- Washington Stormwater Center Public Education and Outreach position: Anne Melrose has been hired to this position and has begun to create a working group of EW Permittee administrators to develop Wish List and plan to implement new PE&O materials.
- EWSG Yakima Meeting: Yakima County and the City of Yakima host the November EWSG meeting at the Office of Emergency Management in Union Gap. This was a hybrid meeting with several jurisdictions attending in person as well as many joining remotely via Teams. There were several presenters in person.
- O&M Good housekeeping: Update/review of Good Housekeeping manuals are a requirement of the current NPDES permit due by December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. Yakima County is planning on creating new manuals in the next permit cycle and is being incorporated in the Stormwater Master Plan Project that is beginning in early 2023. A revised street sweeping program and tree canopy cover have been identified as new elements.
- Ordinance Creation/Updates: Ordinance updates are due by December 31, 2022.
- Regional Manual equivalency: Manual will be re-evaluated for an update after permit reissuance and the Stormwater Management Manual for Eastern Washington has been revised.
- Mid-Yakima River Basin Bacteria TMDL: Multiple jurisdictions from the area will be responsible for the conditions of the TMDL. City of Yakima is taking the lead in establishing a testing protocol through a QAPP.
- BMP Manual Status: Chapters 4-6 have been reviewed by the TAC group. Chapters 7-9 and Training Material are in the development stage.
- 2022 Central Washington State Fair: The Yakima Regional Stormwater booth had a new location within the Yakima SunDome. Community member traffic and interaction was good, many stormwater related materials were distributed.
- Capacity Grant amendment/Water Quality Grants: Capacity grant amendments will be sent out after all PRPR's are processed. Permittees are still awaiting amendment for additional funding.
- Eastern Washington Municipal Stormwater Permit Reissuance Language Discussion: The RSWG after reviewing proposed permit reissuance language determined upload comments as a group.
