Describe Fiscal Impact:

Grants an additional \$54,135 to the current \$785,915 for a new total of \$840,050 to Yakima Neighborhood Health Services.

Background Information:

This is a modification to a current contract. The additional funding comes from Foundational Community Supports (FCS) added to the State Department of Commerce to the current CHG (HEN) grant. FCS provides a bridge period for households who are no longer HEN eligible. YNHS is one of two eligible grantees from Commerce for this FCS Bridge funding. All other aspects of the contract remain the same.




YNHS-HEN-2024 Modification 3

Whereas, Yakima County, a subdivision of the State of Washington (hereinafter described as the "County" or "Yakima County"), and Yakima Neighborhood Health Services, have entered into a contractual relationship with Agreement 191-2023 to provide homeless services.

Whereas, both parties entered into and executed a contract for existing contract on August 1, 2023 (date of original agreement) and,

Whereas,

Now therefore, the parties agree to the following:

1. There is a new funding which creates a bridge period of rent assistance for households enrolled in FCS, prioritizing households enrolled in Supportive Employment, who no longer have a HEN Referral from Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) due to increased income or other changes in eligibility.
2. Eligible households are as follows:

HEN households no longer have a HEN Referral from DSHS. This includes:

Households who:

- Are currently receiving HEN rent assistance.
- Homeless and at-risk households who
- Received a HEN Referral within the last six months but were not able to identify permanent housing.

OR

- Received rent assistance in the past but exited the program within the last six months.

AND

- Households enrolled in FCS. FCS households enrolled in the Supportive Employment should be prioritized.

AND

Household income is at or below 80 % Area Median Income.

3. The housing provider must:
 - a. work with the household on a housing stability plan to secure affordable permanent housing with the knowledge that this funding expires June 30, 2025.
 - b. Ensure HMIS projects are set up specifically for this funding and data entered accurately.
