**EXHIBIT F**

**LH-DV-SHELTER-2024 MODIFICATION 2**

Whereas, Yakima County, a subdivision of the State of Washington (hereinafter described as the “County” or “Yakima County”), and The Lighthouse - Advocacy, Prevention, and Education Center, have entered into a contractual relationship with Agreement 216-2023 to provide homeless services.

Whereas, both parties entered into and executed a contract for existing contract on August 22, Whereas, the Washington State Department of Commerce has identified the need to provide additional funding to homeless service provider workforce to address the challenges posed by inflation.

Now therefore, the parties agree to the following:

1. Budget: The budget adds a new budget category ‘Inflation Increase’ for the amount of \$29,380 for a new total contract value of \$69,453.

2. Funding use is to maintain current levels of homeless subsidies and services and to stabilize the homeless service provider workforce. Commerce expects grantees to prioritize salary increases or retention stipends for their homeless service provider workforce, and to the extent possible, offset other inflation costs.
3. This is a one-time budget increase and will not be sustained with future funds.
4. Allowable uses for these funds are for any allowable Consolidated Homeless Grant activity.
5. That all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain the same and shall be performed by the parties.
6. That the above modifications shall be effective upon full execution of the parties.
