Review Local Data Committee Charter	<p>Melissa explained what is there now and discussion on how to incorporate this into the YHC Homeless charter.</p> <p>A draft of the Data Committee roles/responsibilities were reviewed. There was a motion to add the second to last paragraph and bulleted items from the draft document into the YHC coalition charter.</p>
Review Local Dashboards	<p>Ivan reviewed local data dashboards that included enrollment numbers throughout the last several years and Point-In-Time Counts. Dashboards included Demographic data regarding 2023 enrollments, feedback was asked for improving Household Composition graph, YYA with children had not been de-duplicated, included in both YYA and Families with Children. Committee members suggested to create a fourth category to address Youth and Young Adults with children.</p>
HMIS Data Quality: Internal Data Audit vs External Data Audits	<p>Melissa reviewed the dashboard slides and Dave reviewed the entries and associated data. Data quality is more than project entry and exit. Improve local tracking of length of time homeless and exit to housing (destinations). Reduction in "Exits to Unknown" will improve and provide quality data can be measured.</p>
