WHEREAS, the Yakima County Flood Control Zone District was formed under authority of RCW 86.15, by Resolution of this Board No. 21-1998, adopted January 13, 1998; and,

WHEREAS, as required by the formation resolution the activities of the Flood Control Zone District have been reviewed by the Board of County Commissioners and the need to provide ongoing revenue has been considered; and,

WHEREAS, at the direction of the Board of County Commissioners and under the supervision of the County Engineer, the Flood Control Zone District is currently engaged in multi-jurisdictional flood hazard reduction projects that will extend well beyond 2006; and,

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is necessary to ensure the continuation of the activities of the Flood Control Zone District, such activities including preparing and implementing flood hazard management plans, gathering and updating information about flooding problems, obtaining federal and state flood grants, carrying out public education and involvement about flooding problems, leading inter-jurisdictional coordination on flooding concerns, and increasing the readiness for flood events and the ensuing response; and,

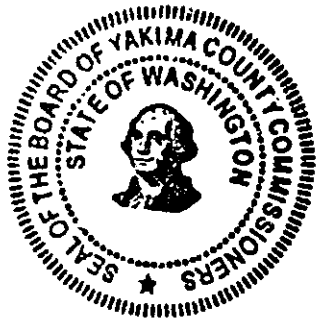
WHEREAS, continuation of the activities of the Flood Control Zone District requires dedicated funds and is in the best public interest of the County and for the general public health, safety, benefit, welfare, and economic development and use; and,


WHEREAS, a notice of public hearing was published as required by RCW 36.32.120 and a public hearing was held on Tuesday, May 4, 2004 at 10:30 a.m., for the purpose of hearing the testimony of interested citizens; now, therefore,


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the Flood Control Zone District annual ad valorem tax levy of \$0.10/\$1,000 of assessed property value shall continue in and beyond 2006 as an ongoing assessment; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer, or their designee, shall periodically review the levy amount and, as needed, bring forward to the Board a request for an adjustment as required to ensure the proper funding and operation of the Flood Control Zone District.


