WHEREAS, on the 4th day of November, 1997, in a regular session, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") unanimously passed Resolution No. 97-520 initiating the creation of a proposed County-wide Flood Control Zone District in accordance with RCW 86.15.010, et seq., and amendments, changes and alterations and additions thereto; and,

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing of the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to establish a Yakima County Flood Control Zone District was given, made and published as provided by law and such hearings on the establishment of said Flood Control Zone were held on December 6, 1997, at 7:00 p.m., and January 6, 1998, at 7:00 p.m., in the Board of County Commissioners Meeting Room in the Yakima County Courthouse in Yakima, Washington; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that there is a public necessity for the establishment of the Yakima County Flood Control Zone District and that it is in the best public interest of the County and for the general public health, safety, benefit, welfare and economic development and use; now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that there is established a county-wide flood control zone district which shall be and is hereby designated and named **Yakima County Flood Control Zone District**, which shall have all the powers, authorities and duties provided in RCW 86.15, et seq., and any and all amendments, changes or alterations thereto or laws pertaining to such, and including provisions as herein provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the boundaries of said district are hereby established, and the same hereby are declared to be as described in RCW 36.04.390, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northwest Corner of Township 6 North, Range 12 East, W.M.; thence East along the North boundary of Township 6 North until said line intersects the range line between Range 23 East, W.M. and Range 24 East, W.M.; thence North along said range line to the Columbia River; thence North up the midchannel of said river to the Southeast Corner of Kittitas County; thence along the southern boundary of Kittitas County to the summit of the Cascade

Mountains; thence southerly to the Southeast Corner of Lewis County; thence West along the line of said county to the Northeast Corner of Skamania County; thence along the East line of Skamania County to the line between Townships 6 and 7 North; thence East along said line to the place of beginning.

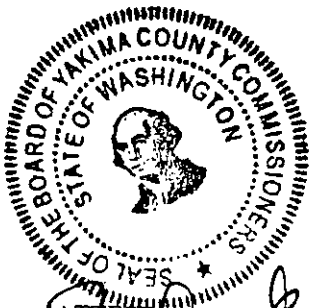
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area described herein as such zone boundaries incorporate any and all watersheds located in said described boundaries:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the annual assessment rate established for the administration and operation of the district shall not be more than \$0.10/\$1,000 of assessed property value until the year 2006 and shall not be reestablished in the year 2005 without a public hearing and majority vote by the Board of County Commissioners.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governing body shall be the Board as Yakima County Flood Control Zone District Supervisors and the administration of affairs of the zone district shall be under the Yakima County Engineer. They shall have all the powers granted by law.
